The Level 2 Award in Principles of Paediatric Emergency First Aid is a 1 day stand-alone qualification that matches the content of Unit 1 of the Level 2 Award in Paediatric First Aid (2 day course).

Who Should Attend

This qualification would suit candidates who have short-term responsibility for infants and children; for example in a visitor centre or for parents/carers who want to develop some basic first-aid skills for children.

Outline programme

The training programme for this Unit covers the following topics:

- the role of the paediatric first aider
- dealing with emergencies
- management of an unconscious casualty
- management of a casualty who is not breathing normally
- management of a casualty who is choking
- management of a casualty who is in shock
- management of a casualty who has a bleeding wound

It also provides the opportunity to practise the skills needed to administer first aid to an infant/child who is:

- unconscious
- not breathing
- Choking
- bleeding from a wound and in shock

Course Duration

The course is 1 day in duration (6 hours + exam)

Assessment Method & Certification

The assessment will be by the completion practical assessments during the course and a multiple choice question examination at the end of the course. On successful completion of the course, delegates will receive a certificate of competence, which is valid for 3 years.

Candidates wishing to obtain a Nationally Accredited Qualification would sit the exam for the relevant Awarding Body (for the additional price of the certification and exam fee of the Awarding Body).
